The question that comes into your mind is "is that even possible?", well I should say yes it is in fact it will make a nice full plant.

You can plant them closer together so it is easy to attach them to a moss pole if you ever want to do that, but in my experience it doesn't actually matter.

Some people ask is it possible to keep two Monsteras in one pot? Do we need them to separate? The answer is yes it is possible to keep multiple Monsteras in one pot.

If you are planting Monsteras from cuttings it is possible to them to connect to each other and grow with each other.

You might get shocked if find out the plants you are keeping are made up from multiple smaller plants, you can choose whether to separate them or let them be in one pot is your decision.

If you ever witness that your Monstera's roots are growing out of the drainage hole, it indicates that the pot you are using is getting small, even if you have changed it couple months ago you need to change it again soon, it is actually good sign that the requirements are met that it made your plant to grow that fast.

You might witness that aerial roots of the plant grow out of the pot, it is actually pretty normal, and you can do couple of thing with them if you are not annoyed by their look you can easily let them be in the open but if you don't want them to be seen you can either put them back in the pot or just them.

I did a research on it and it comes up that it doesn't do anything if you want to cut them so fell free to do whatever you want.

To sum up everything that has been stated so far, planting more than one Monsteras in one pot is possible and in fact after some time they become one plant whole.so if you have couple small Monsteras and one big pot you can easily repot all of them into the bigger pot and let them grow.
