Flowers of these plants don't want to bloom in the heat, if you plant this, it will bloom well until summer starts and weather gets warmer and warmer.

At that time the plant will wilt and will stop producing flowers.

Is it possible to grow Pannies in summer time?

Of course, depends on where you live, you can grow any types you want.

You can find some varieties that have been developed for these kinds of situations and their heat tolerant are high, but they also are not big fan of hot weathers.

Even if you have these heat tolerant Pannies, you should be careful.

If the temperature of the location you live and you keep Pannies in, goes over 21°C (70 °F) they still will wilt a little and you will not witness their amazing blooming.

If you live in locations where the warmest temperature is below 21°C (70 °F), then I suggest you to plant them in summer time because that's the best time to plant these plants.
